1 At the end, add the following:

2 **SEC. 3. REPORT ON DATA SECURITY PROCEDURES OF THE**  
3 **BUREAU OF THE CENSUS.**

4 (a) REVIEW.—The Secretary of Commerce shall con-  
5 duct a review of the data security procedures of the Bu-  
6 reau of the Census, including such procedures that have  
7 been implemented since that data breach of systems of the  
8 Office of Personnel Management that occurred during fis-  
9 cal year 2015.

10 (b) REPORT.—

11 (1) REQUIREMENT.—Not later than 90 days  
12 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-  
13 retary shall submit to the Committee on Homeland

1 Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate  
2 and the Committee on Oversight and Government  
3 Reform of the House of Representatives a report on  
4 the review required by subsection (a).

5 (2) CONTENTS.—The report required by para-  
6 graph (1) shall—

7 (A) identify all information systems of the  
8 Bureau of the Census that contain sensitive in-  
9 formation;

10 (B) described any actions carried out by  
11 the Secretary of Commerce or the Director of  
12 the Bureau of the Census to secure sensitive in-  
13 formation that have been implemented since  
14 that data breach of systems of the Office of  
15 Personnel Management that occurred during  
16 fiscal year 2015;

17 (C) identify any known data breaches of  
18 information systems of the Bureau of the Cen-  
19 sus that contain sensitive information; and

20 (D) identify whether the Bureau of the  
21 Census stores any information that, if combined  
22 with other such information, would comprise  
23 classified information.
