## A BILL

To amend the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act to provide eligibility for broadcasting facilities to receive certain disaster assistance, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Emergency Informa-  
5 tion Improvement Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY OF BROADCASTING FACILITIES FOR**  
2 **CERTAIN DISASTER ASSISTANCE.**

3 (a) PRIVATE NONPROFIT FACILITY DEFINED.—Sec-  
4 tion 102(11)(B) of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief  
5 and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5122(11)(B))  
6 is amended by inserting “broadcasting facilities,” after  
7 “workshops,”.

8 (b) CRITICAL SERVICES DEFINED.—Section  
9 406(a)(3)(B) of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief  
10 and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5172(a)(3)(B))  
11 is amended by striking “communications,” and inserting  
12 “communications (including broadcast and telecommuni-  
13 cations),”.
