4 (a) In General.—Except as provided in subsection		
5 (c), not later than 180 days after the date of enactment		
6 of this Act—		
7 (1) the Director of National Intelligence, in co-		
8 ordination with the heads of other agencies, shall—		
9 (A) identify all unclassified information		
10 systems that provide access to information that		

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1	when combined with other unclassified informa-
2	tion, may comprise classified information;
3	(B) assess the risks that would result from
4	the breach of each unclassified information sys-
5	tem identified in subparagraph (A); and
6	(C) assess the cost and impact on the mis-
7	sion carried out by the each agency that owns
8	an unclassified information system identified in
9	subparagraph (A) if the system were to be sub-
10	sequently classified; and
11	(2) the Director of National Intelligence shall
12	submit to the appropriate congressional committees
13	a report that includes the findings under paragraph
14	(1).
15	(b) FORM.—The report submitted under subsection
16	(a)(2) shall be in unclassified form, but may include a
17	classified annex.
18	(c) Exception.—The requirements under subsection
19	(a)(1) shall not apply to the Department of Defense on
20	an element of the intelligence community.
