1SEC. 2. AGREEMENTS RELATED TO NUCLEAR PROGRAM OF2IRAN DEEMED TREATIES SUBJECT TO AD-3VICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.

4 (a) TREATY SUBJECT TO ADVICE AND CONSENT OF 5 THE SENATE.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any agreement reached by the President with Iran 6 7 relating to the nuclear program of Iran is deemed to be 8 a treaty that is subject to the requirements of article II, 9 section 2, clause 2 of the Constitution of the United States 10 requiring that the treaty is subject to the advice and con-11 sent of the Senate, with two-thirds of Senators concurring.

12 (b) LIMITATION ON SANCTIONS RELIEF.—Notwith-13 standing any other provision of law, the President may 14 not waive, suspend, reduce, provide relief from, or otherwise limit the application of sanctions under any other 15 16 provision of law or refrain from applying any such sanc-17 tions pursuant to an agreement related to the nuclear pro-18 gram of Iran that includes the United States, commits the 19 United States to take action, or pursuant to which the 20 United States commits or otherwise agrees to take action, regardless of the form it takes, whether a political commit-21 22 ment or otherwise, and regardless of whether it is legally 23 binding or not, including any joint comprehensive plan of 24 action entered into or made between Iran and any other 25 parties, and any additional materials related thereto, including annexes, appendices, codicils, side agreements, im-26

plementing materials, documents, and guidance, technical
or other understandings, and any related agreements,
whether entered into or implemented prior to the agree ment or to be entered into or implemented in the future,
unless the agreement is subject to the advice and consent
of the Senate as a treaty and receives the concurrence of
two-thirds of Senators.
