2	by the Department of State, the President, and Con-
3	gress, the Government of the Democratic Republic
4	of Congo began issuing exit permits to internation-
5	ally adopted children and committed to completing
6	all unresolved cases by the end of March 2016.
7	(3) As of March 31, 2016, exit permits had
8	been issued to nearly 330 adopted children, but ap-
9	proximately 100 adopted children remain stranded
10	in the Democratic Republic of Congo, including at
11	least two children adopted by Wisconsin families.
12	(b) SENSE OF THE SENATE.—The Senate—
13	(1) urges the Government of the Democratic
14	Republic of Congo to complete its review of all unre-
15	solved international adoption cases as soon as pos-

17	(2) calls upon the United States Government to
18	continue to treat the release of internationally adopt-
19	ed children from the Democratic Republic of Congo
20	as a priority until all cases have been resolved.
