- (b) REPORT.—The Director of the Office of Manage-15 16 ment and Budget shall submit to Congress a report indi-17 cating the final amount appropriated for each appropriation account for which amounts are made available under 18 19 any division of this Act and the amount of each allocation of such an appropriation, as reduced in accordance with 20 21 subsection (a).
