(a) In General.—The Administrator of the Trans-				
portation Security Administration may not accept a pro-

respect to an alien who is being removed from the United				
States in accordance with the immigration laws (as such				
term is defined in section 101 of the Immigration and Na-

(c) Prohibited Document Defined.—In this sec-				
tion, the term "prohibited document" means any of the				
following:				
(1) U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforce-				
ment Form I–200, Warrant for Arrest of Alien (or				
any successor form).				
(2) U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforce-				
ment Form I–205, Warrant of Removal/Deportation				
(or any successor form).
