4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection
5 (c), not later than 180 days after the date of enactment

7 (1) the Director of National Intelligence, in co8 ordination with the heads of other agencies, shall—
9 (A) identify all unclassified information
10 systems that provide access to information that,

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1	when combined with other unclassified informa-
2	tion, may comprise classified information;
3	(B) assess the risks that would result from
4	the breach of each unclassified information sys-
5	tem identified in subparagraph (A); and
6	(C) assess the cost and impact on the mis-
7	sion carried out by the each agency that owns
8	an unclassified information system identified in
