Dear Dr. Anderson:

Pursuant to its authority under Senate Resolution 94 (119th Cong.), the Permanent Subcommittee on Investigations ("PSI" or "the Subcommittee") is conducting a review of the development, deployment, and safety of COVID-19 vaccines, including the adverse events and injuries associated with these vaccines. Due to your role during the development, deployment, and safety monitoring of the COVID-19 vaccines, the Subcommittee respectfully requests that you make yourself available for an interview.

I hope that you will be cooperative and fully transparent regarding your involvement and knowledge of these issues. However, I am mindful of past efforts by Department of Health and Human Services personnel to conceal records relating to the development, safety, and efficacy of the COVID-19 vaccines.¹ Any attempt to obstruct or delay responses to this request will result in compulsory process.

The Subcommittee requests that you be available by no later than August 14, 2026 to schedule this interview.
